SCOPE

- Short Term Scientific Missions (STSM) are institutional visits aimed at supporting mobility, fostering collaboration between individuals as well as institutions.
 - Should specifically contribute to the scientific objectives of the COST Action
 - Allowing
 - Learn new techniques,
 - Gain access to specific data, instruments and/ or methods not available in their own institutions/ organizations





To Whom?

STSM applicants

- PhD Student engaged in an official research programme
- Postdoctoral individual
- Employed individual by, or affiliated to, Institution, organisation or legal entity which has within its remit a clear association with performing research
 - The institutions / organisation or <u>legal entity where applicants pursue their main strand of research</u> are considered as **Home Institutions**



To Where? Host Institution - Institution / organisation that will host the successful applicant

- In a different country other than the Home Institution located.
- The following table shows different possibilities for Home/Host Institutions


How to do it?

Eligible STSM applicants must submit their STSM applications online





Important information for submission

- Supporting documents required
 - **CV** Letter of Support by Home Institution Written Agreement by HI ensuring the development of the working plan
- Duration Minimum of 5 calendar days that includes travel
- Period Within a single Grant Period (1st May 30th April) ≠STSM Grant Period.

• Grant period: 1 st May 2021– 30 th April 2022	•	STSM period: 1 st July 2021 - 28 th February 2022
• Open calls: 1 st May - 1 st June 2021 (One month)	•	Final report send WITHIN 30 DAYS calendar days after the STSM finished
• STSM Committee decision send to Grant Holder: Until 15 th June 2021		(As soon as possible) – Maximum limit: 30th March
• Final decision from Grant Holder: Until 30 th June 2021	•	Payment after aprove the report - Maximum limit: 30th April

- Financial support The calculation of the financial contribution for each STSM must respect the following criteria
 - Up to a maximum of **3 500** € in total can be afforded to each successful applicant
 - Up to a maximum of **160** €/day can be afforded for accommodation and meal expenses
 - Up to a maximum of **300** € can be afforded for travel costs



EVALUATION (Ranking) criteria


- CV scientific background should be relevant to the specific objectives of RIBMINS: 0 (No, Not defined); 1 (Yes)
- Early Career Investigator: 0 (No), 1 (Yes)
- Home institution has within its remit a clear association with performing research regarding RIBMINS objectives: 0 (Not suitability/Not defined); 1 (Yes)
- Scientific Scope Contribution to the RIBMINS scientific objectives: 0** (Not valid); 1 (Scarce contribution); 2 (Medium contribution); 3 (Important contribution)
 - **Proposal with no valid scientific scope (0 classification) for RIBMINS objectives will be directly rejected
- Working plan valid Must support the scientific objectives of the STSM application: 0 (Not valid); 1(Scarce support); 2 (Medium support) and 3 (Upmost support)
