

STSM at the University of Turin (6th-16th June 2022)

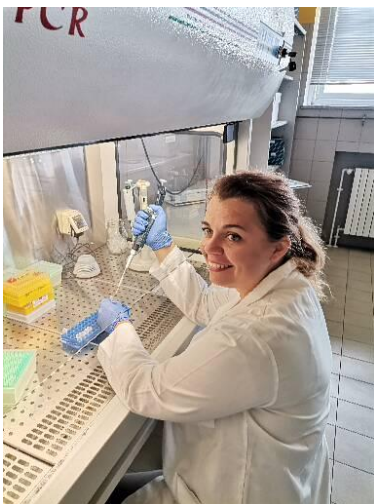
The aim of the STSM was to learn how to perform molecular detection of *Sarcocystis* spp. in cattle and wild boars.
