Abstracts need to fall within the scope of issues covered by RIBMINS described below. Please be aware that acceptance of an abstract does not guarantee physical presence at the conference, as only limited funds for on-site attendance are granted by COST.

The Conference covers issues within:

- Scope and targets of meat safety assurance
- Farm-level controls and risk categorisation of farms
- Abattoir-level controls and risk categorisation of abattoirs
- Impact of changes and alternatives to traditional meat inspection
- Meat safety assurance system training, communication and monitoring

Abstract submission

Abstracts should be structured following the official template and should not exceed one page. They should be sent to cost.ribmins@gmail.com by February 1st, 2023 at the latest. Corresponding authors will be notified on receipt of the abstract within three days and will be notified if abstracts were selected for a presentation by February 20th, 2023. All accepted submissions will be part of a virtual poster session, accompanied by a physical poster session for the authors that are able to attend the conference. In addition, abstracts will be published in a digital Book of Abstracts.
