DISSEMINATION CONFERENCE GRANTS

“Consist in financial support to Action participant for their participation in high-level conferences”

Definition: A grant awarded by the Management Committee to an individual to present the COST Action’s work and results at an international well recognized conference organized by third parties.

GENERAL APPLICATION RULES

ELIGIBILITY criteria

- The applicant must be the **Action participant**
- **Period** - The **attendance** at the conference must start and end during the same **Dissemination Grant Period** – Be aware that Grant Period is different from Dissemination Grant Period. Please check on web page <https://ribmins.com/open-calls/>
- **Financial support** - Up to a maximum of 2000 € in total can be afforded per grant for face to face conferences; or 500 € for virtual conferences
- **Supporting documents required** for Dissemination Grants
 - **CV** (including a list of academic publication)
 - **Short description** of your involvement in this COST Action
 - **Acceptance (or invitation) letter** from the conference organisers confirming your presentation
- A **copy** of the **abstract** of the accepted oral presentation focused on promoting the scientific achievements and activities being performed by the RIBMINS COST Action

EVALUATION (Ranking) criteria

- **CV** scientific background should be relevant to the specific objectives of RIBMINS: 0 (No, Not defined); 1 (YES).
- **Scientific Scope** - Contribution to the scientific RIBMINS objectives: 0 (Not valid)**; 1 (Scarce contribution); 2 (Medium contribution) and 3 (Important contribution)
 - **Proposal with no valid scope for RIBMINS objectives will be directly rejected (0 classification).

Note: The value of the application may need to be adjusted after evaluation by the jury members
