GUIDELINES SHORT TERM SCIENTIFIC MISSIONS (STSM)

<u>Definition:</u> A grant awarded by the Management Committee to an individual for supporting physical mobility aiming at capacity building and transfer of knowledge through bilateral/multilateral collaborations during a research stay in a different country

ELIGIBILITY criteria

- STSM applicant (The STSM applicant can be any person with an e-COST profile)
- Supporting documents required
 - STSM grant Application (Application form based on e-COST template: describing: Goals, description of the work to be carried out by the applicant, expected outcomes and description of the contribution to the Action MoU objectives)
 - CV scientific background should be relevant to the specific objectives of RIBMINS
 - **Confirmation of the host** on the agreement from the host institution in receiving the applicant
 - Recommendation letter

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- **Duration** Minimum 5 days
- **Period** The **STSM** application must start and end during the same **STSM Grant Period** Be aware that Grant Period is different from STSM Grant Period. Please check on web page https://ribmins.com/open-calls/
- Financial support Up to a maximum of Up to EUR 4 000,00 per grant
 - Up to a maximum of 160 €/day can be afforded for accommodation and meal expenses
 - Up to a maximum of 300 € can be afforded for travel costs

EVALUATION (Ranking) criteria (If needed)

- CV scientific background should be relevant to the specific objectives of RIBMINS: 0 (No, Not defined); 1 (Yes)
- Young Researcher and Innovator (Researcher or innovator under the age of 40): 0 (No), 1 (Yes)
- **Home institution** has within its remit a clear association with performing research regarding RIBMINS objectives: 0 (Not suitability/Not defined); 1 (Yes)
- **Scientific Scope** Contribution to the scientific objectives: 0** (Not valid); 1 (Scarce contribution); 2 (Medium contribution); 3 (Important contribution)
 - **Proposal with no valid scientific scope for RIBMINS objectives will be directly rejected (0 classification).
- Working plan valid Must support the scientific objectives of the STSM application: 0 (Not valid); 1(Scarce support); 2 (Medium support) and 3 (Upmost support)

Note: The value of the application may need to be adjusted after evaluation by the jury members
