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# **Projects under development**

- Ante-mortem inspection from a distance
- Post-mortem- VetInspector, used in PM-inspection of poultry
- Post-mortem- Vision, for PM- inspection of pigs and cattle







### **Pros**

At lot of countries in Europe experience a shortage of veterinarians and auxiliaries.
Recruiting official veterinarians/ auxiliaries is becoming still more difficult:

Use of new technology may help solve this problem and contribute to freeing official veterinarians/auxiliaries for other tasks

- AMI: Emergency slaughter in remote areas: Animal welfare
- AMI: On the holding of provenance
- PMI: Increased line speed and efficiency
- PMI: Uniform meat inspection





# Possibilities right now.....



As a general rule, the ante-mortem inspection is to be carried out by an official veterinarian, and the AM-inspection at the holding of provenance shall include a physical examination of the animals to determine whether..... ((EU) 2019/624)

The post-mortem inspection is performed by an official veterinarian (under the supervision of the official veterinarian or, where sufficient guarantees are in place, under the responsibility of the official veterinarian) ((EU( 2017/625)) on all carcasses with the one exception that:

The competent authorities may decide, that only a representative sample of poultry from each flock undergoes post-mortem inspection, if food business operators have a system in place to the satisfaction of the official veterinarian, that allows the detection and the separation of birds with abnormalities, contamination or defects ((EU) 2019/627))

So for now the new technology cannot replace traditional meat inspection, but it can be used as a tool in meat inspection



## What to do/how to chance the legislation

- Changing legislation takes time and all 27 MS have a vote
- The Member States shall inform the Commission and other Member States on scientific and tecnological developments, for consideration and further action as appropriate ((EU) 2019/627)
- The implementing legislation ((EU) 2019/624 and (EU) 2019/627) is negotiated in a working group and an expert group on food of animal origin
- 07/09/2021: Presentation by the Danish poultry industry of VetInspector, used in PM-inspection of poultry.
- 15/2/2022: Presentation by the Danish Technological Institute, DMRI, of Vision, a new technology for post-mortem inspection of pigs and cattle
- Similar systems are being developed in other European countries. DK would encourage the presentation of these systems in the same fora



### International trade
